Permission from parents for a child to walk home alone from school.

Annwyl rieni,

We usually ask all parents and guardians to come to the gate to pick up their child so that we can pass them safely to an adult. With specific permission from parents we can allow Year 3 and older pupils to walk home alone from school.

If you're comfortable that your child is old and responsible enough to leave school on his/her own, and that the journey is reasonable and safe enough for a child to follow, then you will need to sign this letter that gives us permission to allow your child to walk home and that you take full responsibility for his/her safety for the whole journey home.

It's essential for you be waiting by the school gate before 3.15pm or telephone the school if there are any changes to this arrangement. I'm sure that you'll agree this procedure only tries to ensure children's' safety.
